**RE: Foothills Landfill Gas Collection and Control System Wind Damage**

We would like to sincerely apologize to all Leyden Rock Residents who may have been impacted over the last weekend by a rumbling caused by our Gas Collection and Control System (GCCS). This was caused by wind damage to a gas collection well head.

The issue was resolved on Sunday afternoon after an inspection of the system. One of the collection wells was damaged by the high winds on Saturday, which allowed the system to draw in too much atmospheric oxygen. This in turn made the gas flare operate irregularly thus causing the rumbling.

We understand this may have been disruptive to you in your day-to-day activities, and during the sleeping hours. We deeply regret any inconvenience this may have caused.
